The Cook-Johnson Cemetary is approached from a side road off North Valley Road. This side road runs along the front of the cemetary and into the woods.

Row one is the row nearest to the road, row seventeen is farthest from the road. The stones are lettered from left to ~~left to~~ right.

The rows in this cemetary are not very straight, and it is difficult to say exactly which stones are in which row. Please be patient.
