The Gravestones in the PELHAM HILL CEMETARY, behind the Town Hall, in the Center of Town.

Rows are numbered from east to west, stones within each row are lettered from north to south. To find stone 12G, start at the east wall, and count back twelve rows, then count across A through G, and if all goes well, you are at stone 12G.
