

## THE VALLEY CEMETERY

The Valley Cemetery is located on North Valley Road, on the south side, between Buffam and Amherst Roads. It is divided into two sections, separated by one of several driveways into the cemetery. This one is the westernmost driveway, extending from an old white gate to a vault at the back of the cemetery. Each section faces toward that driveway. Thus, the western section faces east, while the eastern section, which is much larger, faces west. Rows are numbered from Row 1, along the driveway, toward the west, up to Row 9. Row 10 is along the east edge of the driveway, and the row numbers go up toward the east from there. The easternmost row is Row 61. Other driveways are located between rows 23 and 24, between rows 31 and 32, and between rows 41 and 42. These driveways do not have gates, and are usable. The white gate is overgrown by trees, and cannot be opened. Stones are numbered with letters, from left to right within each row.

Every effort has been made to record all information exactly as it appears on the stone, but there are undoubtedly some errors, especially in capitalization, and in punctuation, which is often worn and hard to read. Symbols used in this transcription include / indicating a new line on the stone, // indicating a separation between writings on the stone, , indicating a switch to the back or side of the stone, AE. which is the closest this machine can come to , which is actually on the stone, and bwd) which indicates that this stone is backwards, relative to the rest of the stones in that section.
